In collaboration with the *DM Office Kanjhawala*, our foundation organized an *EWS certificate camp* at **Triveni Devi Vridh Ashram.** Many elderly residents had been struggling to obtain EWS certificates despite seeking assistance from various NGOs. Our intervention led to the successful issuance of EWS certificates for approximately *15 elderly individuals*, thanks to the support and cooperation of *District Magistrate* **Mrs. Ankita Anand (IAS)** and *Deputy District Magistrate* **Mr. Alok Kumar.**



FACILITATING ACCESS TO GOVERNMENT SERVICES

A JOURNEY OF EMPOWERMENT

AADHAR CARD CAMPS BRIDGING THE DOCUMENTATION GAP

On 27th May 2023, in association with the North-West District Administration and Tulsa Devi Memorial Society, we conducted an Aadhar Card camp at **Basti Vikas Kendra**, Sultanpuri. Approximately 50 elderly individuals benefitted from this initiative, receiving assistance in obtaining or updating their Aadhar cards.

Continuing our efforts, on 29th June 2023, we organized another Aadhar Card camp at Triveni Devi Ashram in Jaunti. This time, 54 elderly residents received support in updating their Aadhar cards, enabling them to access essential government services seamlessly.



EMPOWERING THROUGH AWARENESS AND DOCUMENTATION

These camps not only facilitated documentation but also raised awareness about various *government schemes and policies* among the elderly population. By eliminating barriers to access, we empowered elderly citizens to avail themselves of the support and benefits they are entitled to.

RAJWANTI'S STORY OF COURAGE

"WITH 24X7 CARE FOUNDATION, I FOUND HOPE"

In the bustling area of Dwarka, 67-year-old **RAJWANTI** lives in a tiny jhuggi, embodying resilience amid hardship. Orphaned early in *Alwar, Rajasthan,* and married young, she moved to Delhi with her husband, where they struggled to make ends meet. After her husband's death, Rajwanti became the primary breadwinner, running a small tea stall with her son, who is already dealing with multiple health concerns due to alcohol addiction. She barely manages to cover daily expenses and often relies on charitable donations. Rajwanti's health has suffered due to malnutrition and lack of proper medical care, with long queues at government hospitals and unaffordable private clinics adding to their woes.

Discovered by our team during a survey, Rajwanti was enrolled in our "AASRA" initiative, receiving *monthly food supplies* and access to a 24/7 *emergency ambulance service* under PROJECT NIROG. As a special care beneficiary, she benefits from regular visits by our social workers, ensuring immediate assistance when needed. We are also planning to provide her with a *portable cart* for her *tea stall*, depending on the donations we receive, aiming to boost her income and bring some stability to her life. Rajwanti's story is one of immense courage and determination, and with our



A NEW BEGINNING FOR MR. LALA RAM

In September 2023, our social worker met *Mr. Lala Ram*, a *62-year-old man* in Delhi, faces immense challenges due to health issues. He lives in a poor-condition jhuggi with no toilet and limited income. After a leg amputation in 2023, he can't work as a tea seller anymore.

His family struggles to cope: his wife's income is insufficient, his younger son is disabled, and his elder son doesn't contribute. Isolated and depressed, Lala Ram requires constant care.

Our **PROJECT AASARA** provides him with monthly food supplies and helps him get a disability card for government aid. Additionally, our **NIROG PROJECT** offers free ambulance services for medical appointments.

Lala Ram's story shows the positive impact of our organization's support. Regular home visits, emotional support, and access to resources have improved his living conditions and well-being. His journey exemplifies the power of timely assistance and reaffirms our commitment to uplift Delhi's most vulnerable.





THE JOURNEY OF MRS. RAJKUMARI

A LIFE TRANSFORMED

Our volunteers met **Mrs. Rajkumari**, a *63-year-old woman* during a survey. Once middle-class, family tragedy and her husband's addiction led her to a single jhuggi room in Delhi. Living alone with health struggles, she lacked proper food, healthcare, and companionship.

Our organization stepped in, providing *monthly rations, emotional support, and essential appliances.* We accompany her to hospitals, ensuring proper care. This intervention improved her living conditions, health, and well-being. Her story exemplifies the power of community support. We remain dedicated to ensuring her remaining years are filled with dignity and care.



24X7 CARE FOUNDATION SUPPORTED SHAIFIKI JI

TO LIVE A BETTER LIFE

BACKGROUND AND LIVING CONDITIONS *Mrs. Shafiki*, a 65 years old woman lives in a small *Jhuggi* she owns, where everyday life is a challenge. Her home lacks basic amenities such as proper sanitation and reliable electricity. During the rainy season, her dwelling is prone to flooding, exacerbating the conditions already compromised by rat infestations and exposed electrical wiring. Despite these hardships, she resourcefully collects water and manages household tasks.

HEALTH CHALLENGES Mrs. Shafiki battles health issues, including *cataracts in both eyes* and age-related ailments like *joint pain* and *breathing difficulties*. Despite these challenges, she remains determined to face each day with courage.

PERSONAL TRAGEDIES AND SOCIAL ISOLATION Mrs. Shafiki has endured profound personal losses, including the *deaths of her husband*, *infant son*, and *one of her daughters*. These tragedies have left her socially isolated, adding to the burden of financial struggles and lack of familial support.

ROOTS AND STRUGGLES Originally from *Rampur, Uttar Pradesh*, Mrs. Shafiki's early life was **marked by poverty. She married young and m**oved to Delhi with her late husband, where they faced numerous challenges together.
