24×7 Care Foundation is a prominent non-profit and self-aided organization working with Delhi Police for senior citizens from last five years. It is registered under Societies' Registration Act 1860. We are glad to announce that we are taking care of around 20 thousand senior citizens who are registered with Delhi Police. We are facilitating them with emergency services, 24×7 helpline number, health talks, health camps, legal aid and advice, household assistance, technology assistance, entertainment programs, birthday celebrations and engaging activities. Self help groups among senior citizens is way different idea introduced by our organization.

Aging doesn't ask for privileges before hitting. There is always a sense of detachment and loneliness among elderly people due to generation gap with their children and grandchildren. This is an issue carpeted by our society since ages but we are here to become a bridge between generations and create empathy and understanding of old-age in our young generation.

With the development and high aspiring life, we always run after success and quality life but in this race of development many times we forget to take our foundation relationships with us. This causes disappointment but no surprise to us that today most of our elderly people are living alone, some are being neglected and some are left behind as their children have to move due to some reasons. The only option left with these elderly is to opt for old age homes.

There are around 728 old-age homes in India and our senior citizens are still looking for warmness of their home. We need to stop and think what is missing. We have provided them a roof to live, food to eat and clothes to wear undoubtedly, these are the things we can't survive without, but is SURVIVG is what LIVING? Maybe this is the time to do necessary amendments in our approach of welfare too. We need to focus on dignity, love, protection and happiness. We need to include them in society instead of making a separate world for them. Therefore, our organization is here to take care of senior citizens who are living alone and have no one to take care but living rest of the life in old age home is not their option. We believe that everyone has the right to choose the kind of life they want for themselves. Today if an elderly hesitates to prefer Old Age Homes, 24x7 Care Foundation can be their choice to embrace.

Today protecting our environment is crucial as it affects all the civilization and sustains our economy, therefore we adopted 3 MCD parks to look after its greenery and beautification.

But the struggle to become better and grow to lead a society where each elderly can live a dignified life is constant. - Yoga Session by Atha Yoga Lifestyle.





We have Smart Elder Manual as well to guide the elderly step by step on how to use their smartphones for their own good. In order to encourage them we also distribute Smart Elder Certificates.





#### **Commission of Legal Team**

A panel of 5 advocates has been constituted by our organization in order to deal with the legal cases of the elderly. We receive grievance calls on our helpline no. 7065206000 and after understanding the severity of the case, we forward it to our expert advocates. A telephone call or face-to-face consultancy is arranged for the senior citizens. We not only provide consultancy but a proper solution from drafting to execution has been provided. Today more than 70% of cases are resolved with happy beneficiaries.



## Trusted by Elderly

Today we have built a great rapport with our senior citizens and most of them come forward to support us in order to help other needy elderly people. Senior citizens are willing to sponsor ration, give donations and also cooperate with us in events and festival celebrations. We have more than 40 new elderly donors with us.

Amarjeet Kaur has experienced several hardships in her life. Her disabled spouse, who is paralyzed and has poor vision, lives with her in a rented home. They also don't have a reliable source of income. They lack an adequate source of drinking water. Amarjeet Ji is responsible for both her spouse and her home. When sending birthday greetings, we just learned about her. She initially resisted sharing her sorrow with us, but we sensed something was off, and after much effort on our part, she began to talk about her struggles. She only purchases certain, inexpensive medications since she lacks the money to buy both her and her husband's prescriptions. As soon as we learned of this, we started providing medicine and ration to both of them. We recently learned about her husband's vision problems when we paid her a visit and we made the decision to help her from our end. We are aware that this journey will not be simple for us either, but we do understand that many a little make a mickle. We would request everyone to be a part of this journey and feel the joy of helping a person who is dealing with so much struggle in her life. Our one step can make her life a little bit easier.

#### Janardhan Giri

24X7 Care Foundation conducted a survey in Vikasnagar, Ranhola. There we met Shri Janardhan Giri, 80 years old living in awful conditions. His wife passed away and his son and daughter-in-law don't look after him. When we visited his living place, we found a small room in the office of an advocate, where he works as a cleaning person. Shri Janardhan Giri's living conditions are sorrowful and depressing. He has a negligible source of income. 24x7 care foundation provided him with a monthly ration and ensured him our regular visits and regular calls so that he could see us as his reliable support.









#### C R Nariyal & Sonu Nariyal





Sh. C.R. Nariyal and Smt. Sonu Nariyal is an elderly couple living alone in Vikas Nagar, Ranhola in a rented house with one small room. They don't have any children or family members to look after them. Sh. Nariyal is paralyzed and also visually impaired, which has made him dependent on his wife for day-to-day activities. Smt. Sonu Nariyal has to pick rags from nearby areas to manage monthly expenses. According to the elderly couple, they have to bear Rs 2000 for house rent, which leaves them with no money to manage other expenses. They are deprived of even basic amenities of food and healthcare. We managed to reach these vulnerable oldies and provided them with ration kits and ensured to look after their basic needs henceforth.

#### **Asha Devi**





In today's pricey world, an individual should earn at least 100 rupees per day, but Asha Devi only makes 18 rupees a day, and even then, she must make at least 600 saree falls in a single day. She is about 75 years old and has been living alone since the death of her lone son in 2021. There is no one around to provide her with financial and emotional care,her daughter in law also leaves her home after her son's death and she meets her daughter ocassionally. She doesn't understand how to make a senior citizen or ration card. She is physically unwell as well, making it impossible for her to board a bus and go to a local clinic. She doesn't even own a phone, so she has no connection to technology either. Whenever someone visits her she gets very emotional as she tries to find her expired child's face in every face that she meets. It's not easy for her to spend the rest of her life with the help of only memories that she has of her happy family.

Our team has provided emotional support and monthly ration to Asha Devi Ji. We are regularly connected to her to track her wellbeing.
